ELIGIBILITY

This program honors organizations, institutions, and individuals across the education sector who are leading the charge in data standardization.

CATEGORIES

There are three separate categories for submissions:

- By region
- By role
- By technology

AWARDS

Awards are presented by PESC each year in each category. The PESC Board Review Committee may determine that no award be made in a given year under one or more categories.

JUDGING

All entries are judged by the PESC Board of Directors. Winners will be notified immediately, and a public announcement will be made in coordination with PESC's <u>October 2024 Data Summit</u>. Recognition will take place during the Summit opening General Session.

SUBMISSIONS

Submissions will be accepted until close of business on Friday, September 20, 2024.
